### Literacy in key stage 3: An interim report - January 2015

#### Summary

This report is the second in a series, published in response to a request for advice in the Minister's annual remit letter to Estyn for 2013-2014. It looks at standards in literacy at key stage 3, and how a selection of secondary schools is developing pupils' literacy skills across the curriculum with a particular reference to the implementation, and impact of the first year of the literacy component of the National Literacy and Numeracy Framework (LNF).
