- Darparu gwersi ychwanegol, naill ai o fewn amser ysgol, ar ôl ysgol neu/ac ar benwythnosau a gwyliau, er mwyn sicrhau fod disgyblion yn cael cefnogaeth ychwanegol effeithiol.
- Darparu cwricwlwm amgen ar gyfer disgyblion nad yw cwricwlwm arferol ysgol yn addas ar eu cyfer.

- Hyfforddi athrawon i dargedu cynhaliath yn effeithiol.
- Hyfforddi cymorthyddion i ddarparu cefnogaeth effeithiol, yn arbennig ym maes llythrennedd a rhifedd.
- Gosod pwyslais cynyddol ar gydweithio effeithiol rhwng yr ysgol, y teulu a'r gymuned.

Ysgol y Moelwyn PDG grant expenditure

This grant allocation is used in order to provide additional support for pupils from more deprived backgrounds. The aim is to close the gap between the achievement of pupils from all backgrounds. This work entails:

Personal and practical support.

- Provide mentoring support and personal support.
- Provide additional support to help pupils develop into confident, highly motivated individuals who are proud of themselves and their community.
- Ensure that all pupils have suitable resources to succeed at school.
- Ensure that pupils maintain a high level of attendance at school.

Curricular planning and educational support.

- Implement effective literacy and numeracy intervention programmes in KS3 and specific subjects in KS4.
- Provide additional lessons, either during school time, after school or during the weekends and school vacation, in order to ensure that pupils are provided with additional effective support.
- Provide an alternative curriculum provision for pupils in cases where the usual school curriculum is not suitable.

Tracking and assessment

- Implement a detailed and specific tracking system and review progress regularly.

Staff INSET and system development.

- Train and provide guidance for teachers to target support effectively.
- Train and provide guidance for support team to ensure the provision of more effective literacy and numeracy support.
- Place a more prominent emphasis on effective partnership work between the school, the family and the community.
