www.gwegogledd.cymru, is up and running. We will be using the Maths GCSE PISA VLE as our main platform for sharing resources. You should have already received your user guide from Jo, which explains the content of the Maths VLE and how to access it.

The latest additions to the site are the banks of Exam Questions for each tier. These are arranged by topic following our Exemplar Schemes of Work, and comprise a selection of exam questions and mark schemes, including methodical and contextual questions from both calculator and non-calculator papers, designed so that users can select questions to create their own tests and/or resources.

Exam questions for the first few topics have already been uploaded and the rest will be gradually added over the coming weeks.
