By creating this design, I am hoping to show that I can successfully create the character of Minnie mouse on a set of nails. It is something that I will enjoy doing and and something that I will be proud of at the end.

I am hoping to show my learning journey throughout this project.

Aims:

1. To find out which is the most popular type of nail designs.
2. To gather the equipment I need to create the nails.
3. To create a set of Minnie Mouse nails.

Objectives:

1. Analyse which nail designs are popular amongst celebrities.
2. Identify which design my friends like the most.
3. Identify the tools that I need to create the nails.
4. Calculate the cost involved to create the nails.
5. Create a paper-based design of my final ideas.
6. Apply the polish, glitter and gems to the nails.

In my project, I expect to find out what others think and what they know about nail art, what techniques are involved when creating nail art and what tools are needed to create such a detailed design.

Research Rationale

What research methods am I going to use/ why I have chosen them and what I expect to find out?

I am going to produce a questionnaire and hand each one out to my classmates to get other people's opinions on the designs that I have chosen, by doing this I will see what people dislike and what people like, this will help me decide on a design which I will do for my final.

I am going to research the history behind nail art and behind my theme because this will give me an insight on where nail art came from and I will be researching the history behind my theme so that I know a little bit more about the character that I will be basing my theme around.

Finally I am going to look at other people's designs by looking at photographs and watching step by step video clips so that I get an idea on how I would create my design.

Primary research-

For my primary research, I am going to produce a questionnaire and set up an interview with a tutor on my course who knows the basics of nail art.

My final chose was to create the questionnaire, the reason behind choosing to produce a questionnaire is because I am able to find out other people's opinions on nail art and I am able to give out my questionnaire to people that I know, and classmates for answers off a group of people from around the same age group as myself which makes it easier for them to understand.

I decided not to use the interview method; I stuck to producing a questionnaire.

Secondary research-

For my secondary research, I am going to use the internet to watch you tube tutorials on Minnie Mouse nail art to watch a step by step guide on how it's done so I know for when it comes to doing it myself.

I also had another choice which I was debating on using which was the Google search engine and the Bing search engine to research different information which could help me gather the information that I need for my work but I decided to go with the YouTube tutorials because I think using this is a fast and simple way to help me along with my project.

3. Main body.

History behind nail art

Nail art first started in China. Nail polish began life made from a combination of beeswax, egg whites, gelatine, vegetable dyes, and gum. The Chinese applied the substance and left it to sit for several hours, the result; a pink finish on their nails. This was the beginning of nail art and the earliest records. Egyptians and Indians also practiced nail art in a similar period using an orange dye derived from the Henna plant. Back in the 1300 BC, the colour of nail polish symbolized social class; the colours gold and silver were considered to be the royal, however, were later changes to black and red.

By the turn of the 19th century, nails were tinted with scented red oils, and polished or buffed with a chamois cloth, rather than simply polished. One such polishing product sold around this time was Graf's Hyglo nail polish paste. The modernization of nail design began early in the 19th century. Modern manicures began with the invention of Orange sticks developed in Europe in 1830 and as popularity continue, salons started to pop up across the US by late 19th century.

After the creation of the automobile thus of automobile paint, Cutex produced the first modern nail polishes in 1917 with the introduction of coloured nail glosses, giving new life to nail art. One of the first designs to become popular was what was known as the "moon manicure". This nail art design involved painting the middle of the nail while leaving the moon of the nail unpainted.

The next revolution came from the Revson brothers and Charles Lachman with their invention of a new kind of nail enamel and their creation of the company Revlon. Their use of pigments instead of dyes changed the industry dramatically. This allowed for new colours and designs to quickly be adapted.

Since, nail art has become more creative and artistic and many trends have followed, such as the addition of symbols, crystals, air brushing, nail wraps, magnetic polish, crackle polish, acrylic, gel polish and the list goes on. Nail art has truly become integrated into the world of fashion and is now sported as an accessory to any look.

Minnie mouse's personality-

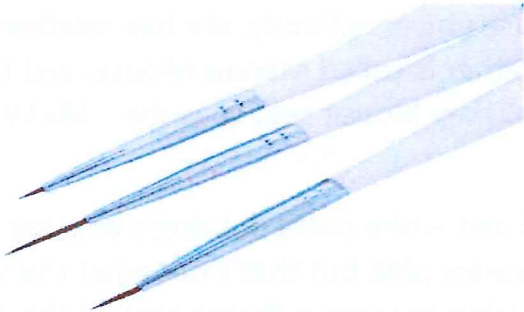

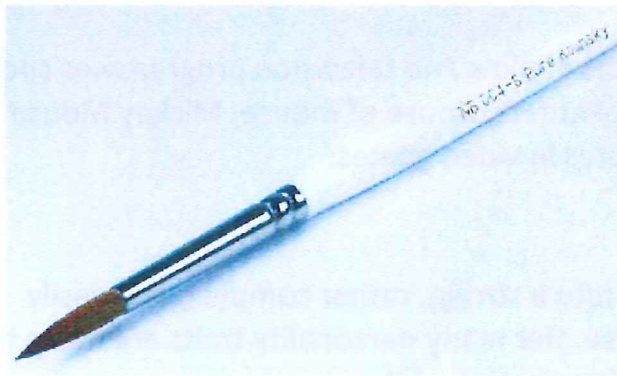
Tools and equipment for nail art

Stripping brushes



This long, thin brush is used for painting skinny lines giving it that smooth line look on your nail . It doesn't offer as much intricacy and control as a detail brush but it makes painting flawless lines a breeze. This brush is perfect for doing snowflake nails, american flag nails, zebra nails, etc...

Detail brush



Possibly the most important nail art brush that is required it is a small detail brush. this brush offers a lot of control and precision for when you're doing complex painting giving it that great detail on your design, but in some ways a detail brush pretty much does the same job as a nail art pen, this brush can be used for designing/creating nails such as leopard nails, neon pattern nails, cartoon nails and tribal nails.

Clean up brush



This is a good brush to use because it doesn't hold much liquid so that it doesn't flood your cuticles with acetone when you're to do a quick swipe to remove a mistake. an angle brush is also good to use because they can get right in those cuticles.

Dotting tool



there used for creating dots,eyes etc..

A Dotting tools, ideally a set of different sizes, is so convenient to have, but you dont need them. Some other things that work are bobby pins, pin heads, dried out pens, the ends of brushes or toothpicks.

Gems



Gems are used to create my dazzle and more detail to your nails or can even to complete your design that is if gems are included.

Glitter



Glitter is used to give your nails sparkle gives them more of a dazzle, shiny effect and you can use it to make a load of different designs.

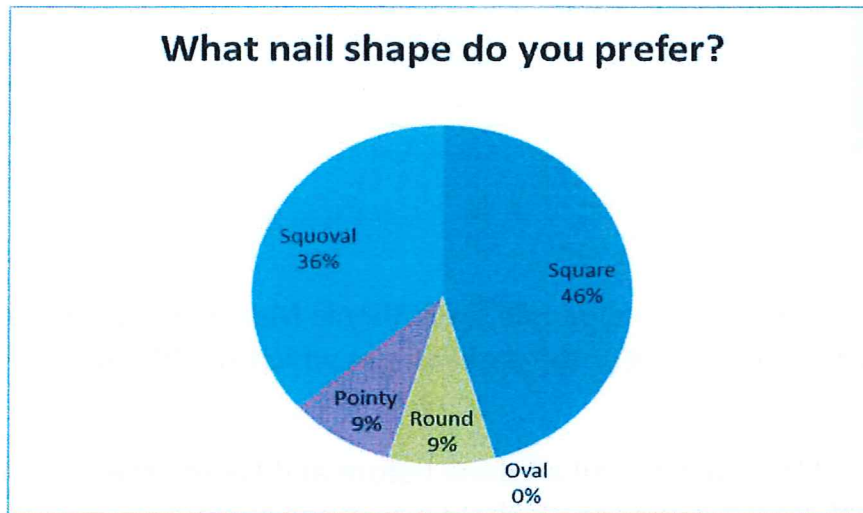


Questionnaire results

By looking at the results I got from my questionnaire it shown me that the people that took the questionnaire were 100% female which means no males took the questionnaire.

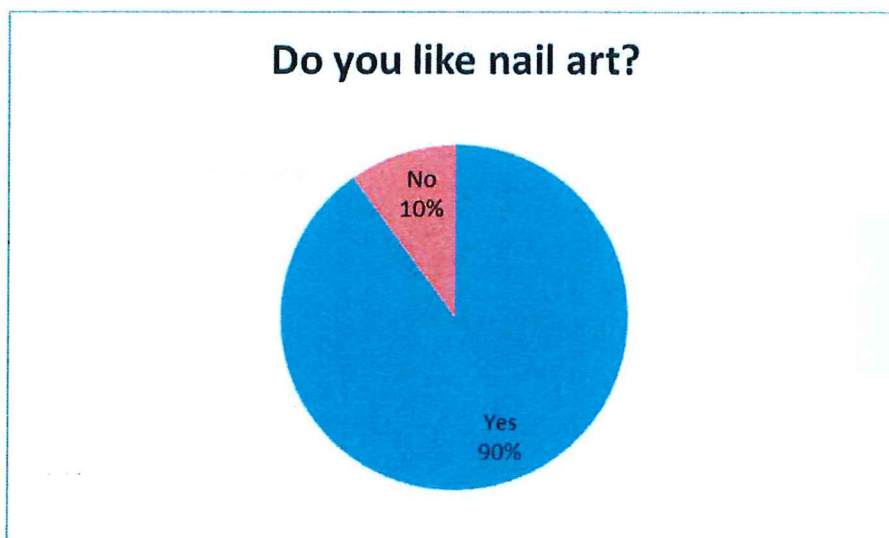
For question two I figured out by looking at the results that the ten people that took the questionnaire were between the ages of 15-20.

Then for question three I made a pie chart to show my results of this question and this is what I got:



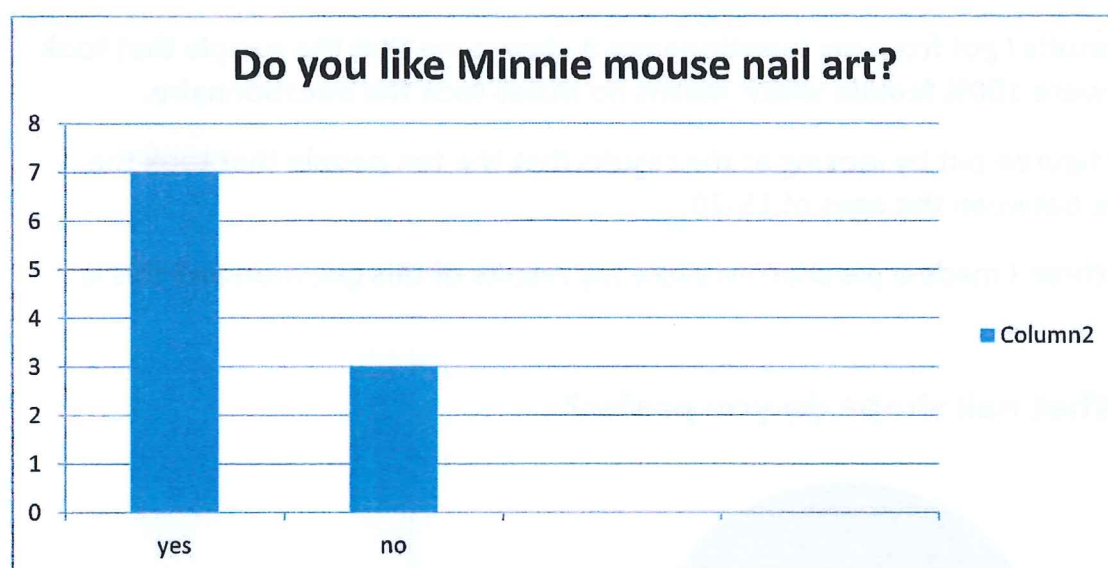
By looking at this chart I can see out of the ten people that took the questionnaire 46% of them preferred to have squared shaped nails.

Question four I asked ten people if they like nail art these are the results I got back:



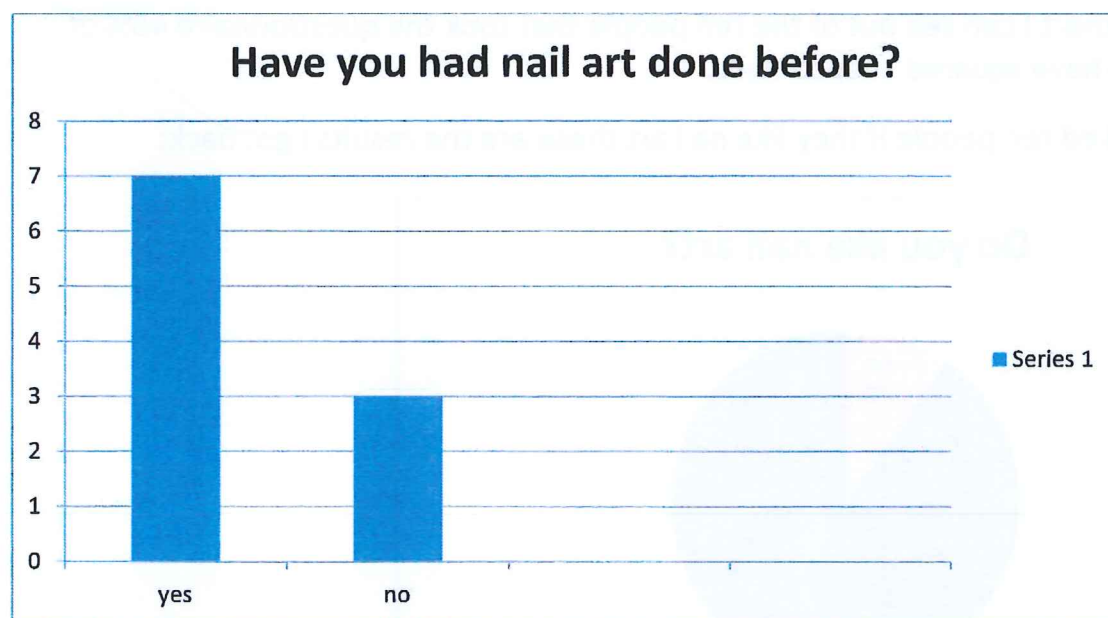
Looking at this chart I can see that 90% of the ten people I asked liked nail art then the over 10% didn't which shows me that more people like it then dislike it.

My four nail art designs

I decided to create a cute minnie mouse nail design because it's not too extreme and because it's simple and straightforward and i'm also and big fan of the minnie mouse family.

Products used to create this design/theme:

- Orly- monroe red
- Orly- white out
- Essence black nail polish
- Silky polish top coat
- Catrice french manicure base coat

I think this nail art theme was created with a simple step by step guide e.g.

1. Using the catrice french manicure (base coat) for the base of the nail.
2. Then using the Orly- monroes red polish on every other finger other than the middle finger, and thumb because thats where you would use the Essence black nail polish to draw a silhouette of minnie mouse's head, to create the silhouette of minnie mouse I think they used the tip of the polish brush then used a dotting tool to draw the ears and the bow but when they drew the bow I think they then changed the colour of the polish by instead of using the Essence black nail polish they used the Monroe red then they added white polka dots using the dotting tool and the Orly- white out nail polish.

3. Then for the other remaining nails which are the index finger, ring and little finger I think they used the Monroe red then applied white polka dots on to each remaining nail using the Orly-white out nail polish.
4. Then to finish the nails I think they then applied 3 strokes of the Silky top coat to prevent the nails from chipping, and cracking and to keep the nails intact.

Products and supplies used to create this design/theme:

- Red nail polish
- White nail polish or white nail art pen
- Black nail polish or black nail art pen
- Peach nail polish
- Base coat and top coat

I think these nails were done by-

To start of I think they started by adding a base coat to each nail to keep the nails strong to stop them from staining throughout the process then they added coats of the red polish on to four of the nails on each hand (Barry M red) then on the ring the left and the right they painted it using a light peach colour by the looks of it that is used to form minnie's face.

After creating minnie's face they then added the white details (the polka dots) to the already painted red nails using a nail art pen or a dotting tool, then with a small bead of polish on a end of a tool they created a uniform of white spots to mimic minnie's dress.

For minnie's face on the accent nail they drew two white ovals which would create minnie's eyes, after the eyes were finished they traced around around the edge of the accent nail to make

the edge of minnie's face then they added the pupils, lashes and the nose using a nail art pen, stripping brush or a dotting tool.

After minnie's face was completed they added the bow detail in black then worked in a series of dots, drawing three to make the centre to make a neat triangle on each side, for minnie's mouth, they drew a curved smile for the tongue I think they would've added two dots in pink polish using the dotting tool. Then to finish off added three strokes of the clear top coat to protect the design/nails.

- Clear base coat
- Red nail polish
- White nail polish
- Clear top coat
- Nail art pen or dotting tool (or both)
- Black nail polish

I think these nails were done by-

First adding a clear base coat to every nail to protect the nails from staining throughout the process and then I think they added two coats of the red polish to four of nails on each hand left and right then on the ring finger they added a black oval shape around the edge of the nail (free edge) by doing that they were able to form minnie's mouse's head then they added the ears with either a nail art pen or a dotting tool then they drew the bow on to the ears using the red polish then once the bow was dried they then added white polka dots to go along with the theme of minnie mouse's dress to create the dots I think they either used a nail art pen or a dotting tool,

then finally to finish off they added three strokes of the clear top coat to each nail on each hand to prevent chipping, cracking and to give the nails a new fresh, shiny look.

Products and supplies used to create this design/theme:

- Black nail polish
- Yellow nail polish
- Red nail polish
- White nail polish
- Dotting tool or nail art pen
- Stripping brush

I think these nails were done by-

First adding a base coat to every nail to protect the nails from staining throughout process of creating them and then on the little finger, thumb and middle finger they added two coats of yellow nail polish then on the remaining fingers, the index they did half of the nail two different colours which are black and red so they would've added to coats of the colours that they used on both sides and then on ring finger they added two coats of red nail polish.

After each nail had been polish I then think they moved on to adding the details by adding the shape of minnie's head in black using a dotting tool on the middle finger, little finger and thumb, after them three fingers were finished I then think they moved on to the index finger and ring finger, on the index they added two yellow dots using a dotting pen or a nail art pen.

The yellow dots are meant to be minnie's shoes then moving on to the ring finger they drew a black silhouette of minnie's head using a dotting tool or a nail art pen, for the white dots curving over minnie's head they used white nail polish and a dotting tool or nail art pen to create the polka dots. After every nail had been completed I think they then moved on to adding three

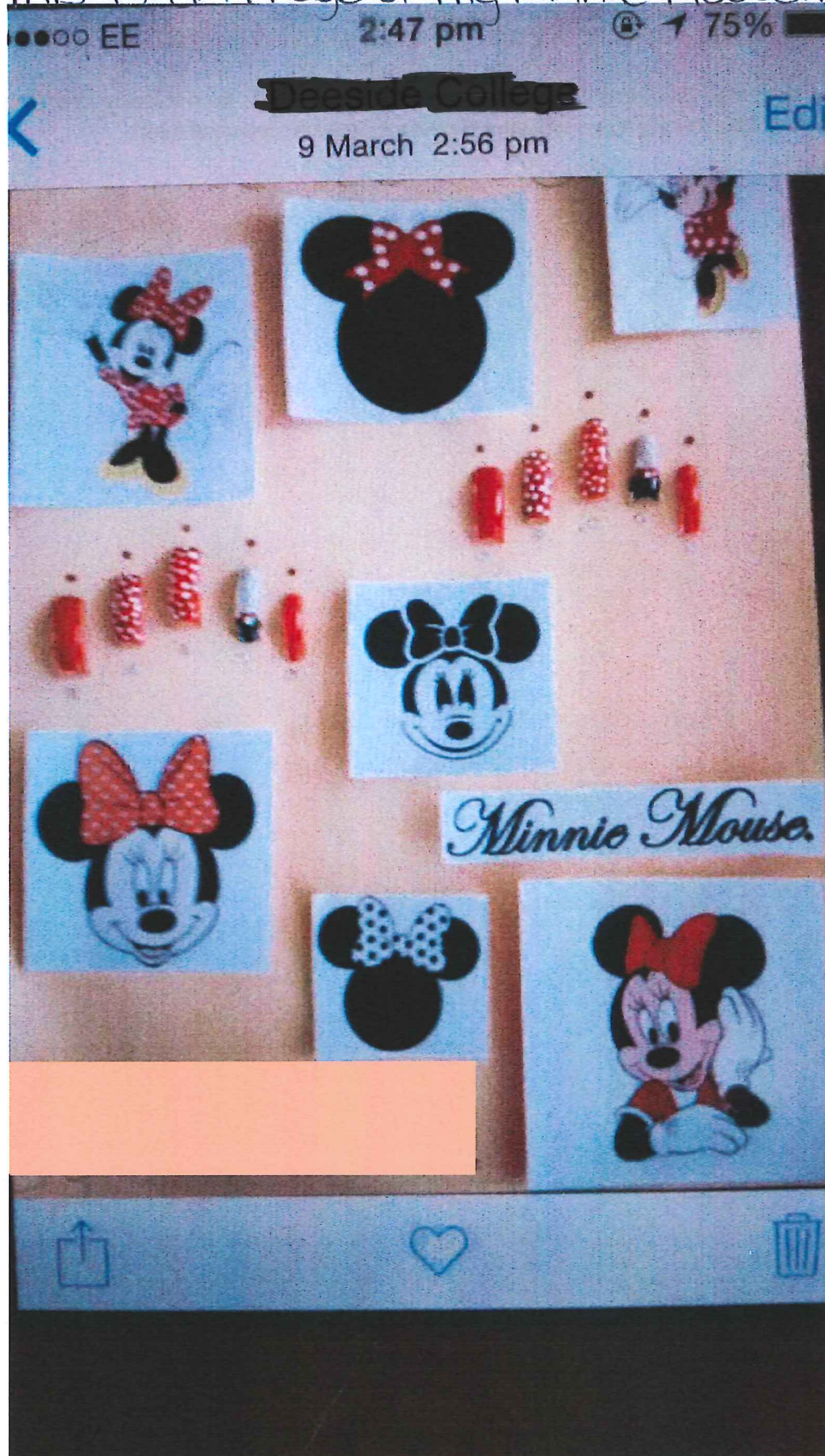

strokes of a clear top coat (polish) to keep/prevent the nails from chipping, cracking etc.. and also to give them a nice shiny effect making them look clean and fresh.

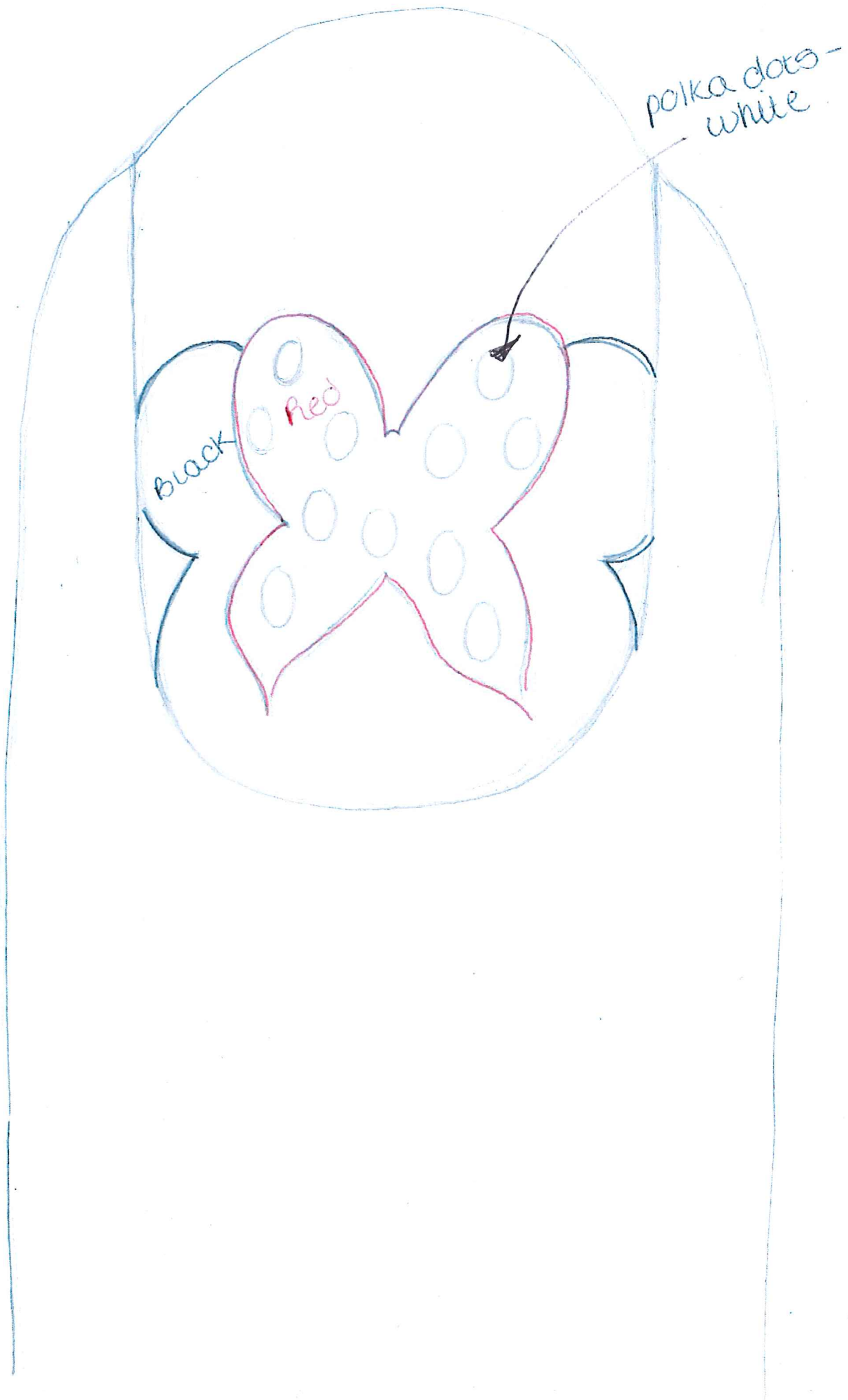


These are my practise nails for my welson bacc project.

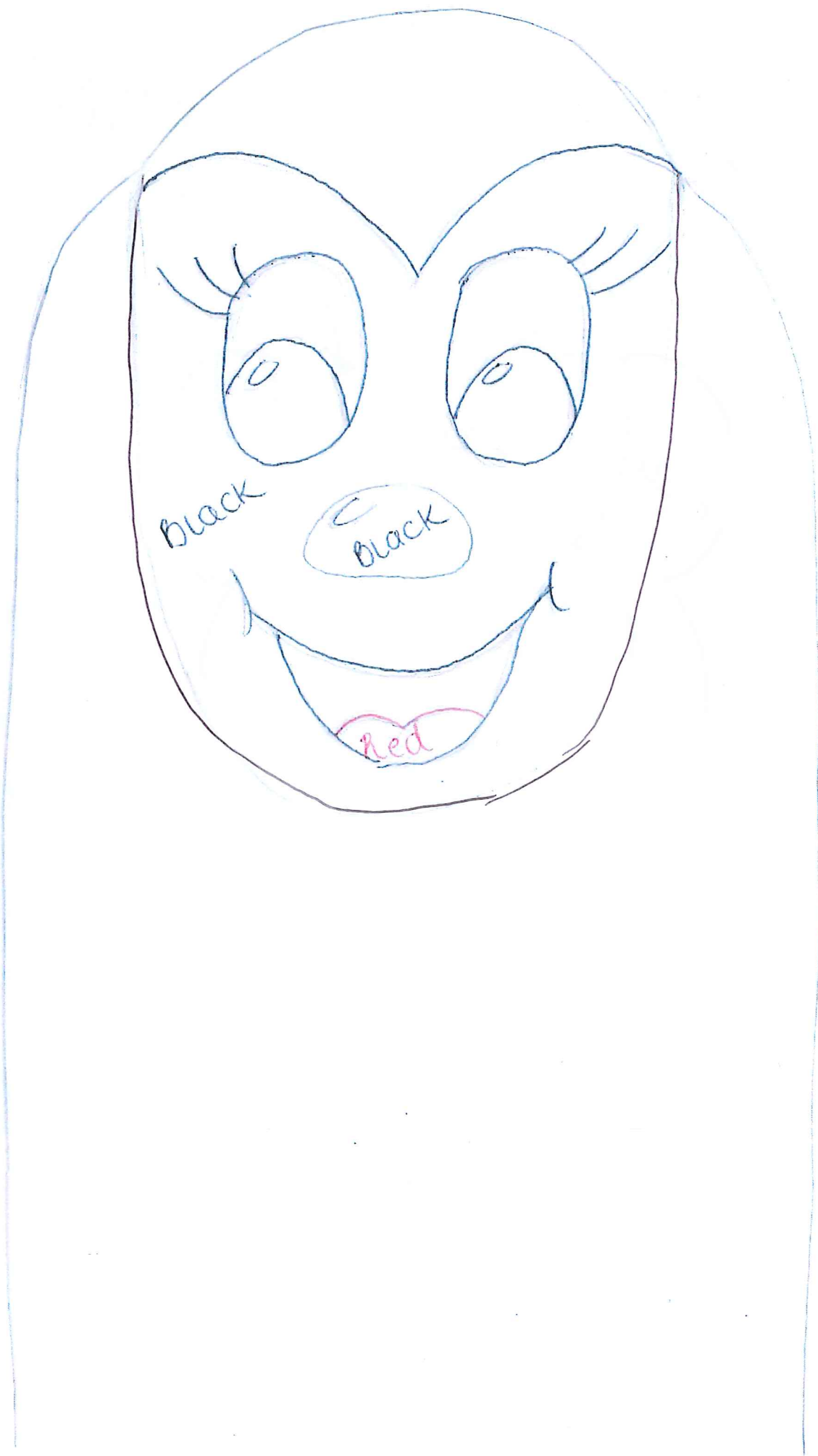
The thumb, index, ring and little finger I painted red but on the index and middle finger I applied some white nail polish to create a polka dot look.

On the ring finger I use black, white, red and glitter polish to create Minnie's head and background.

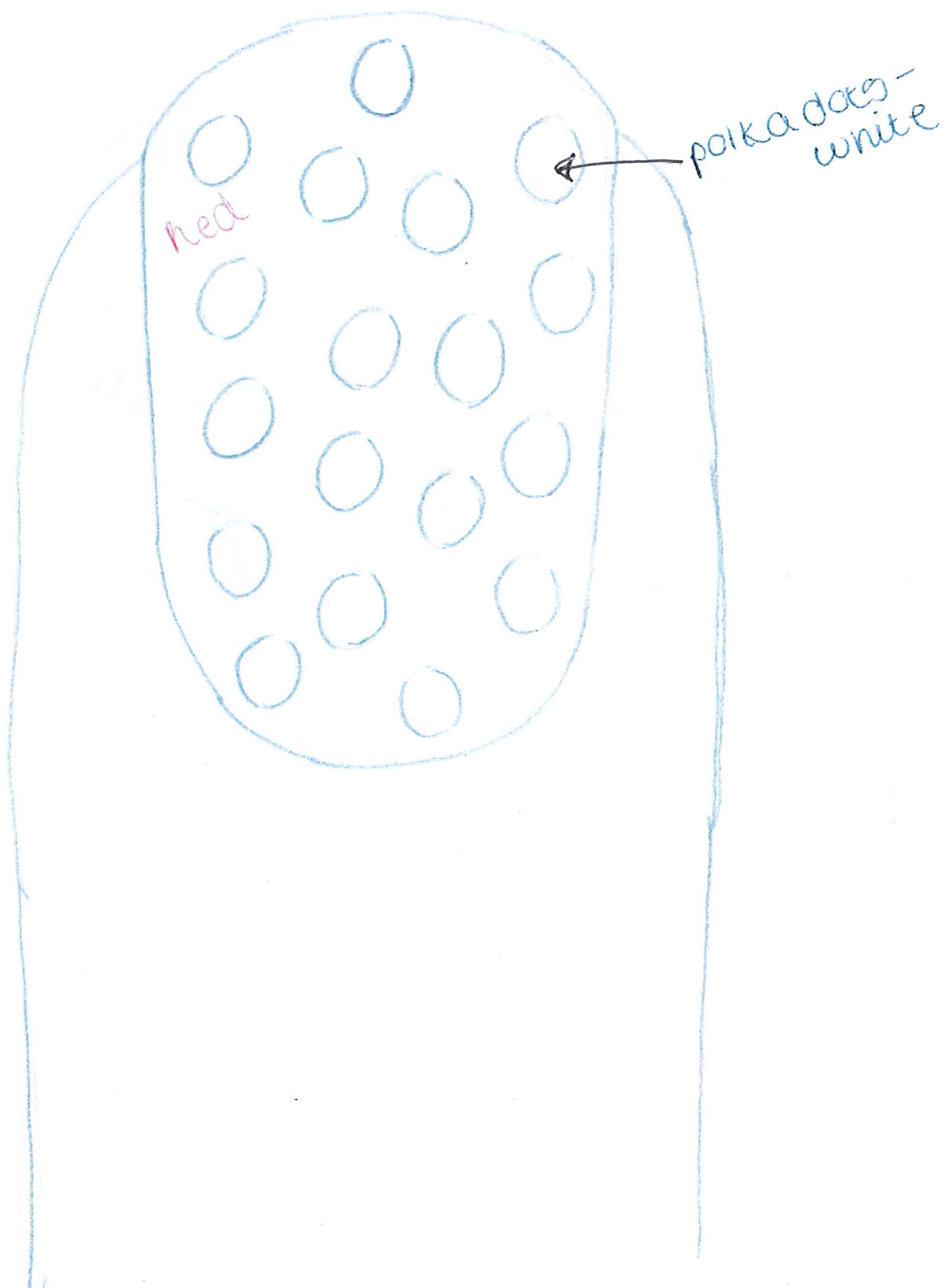
