#### Formative assessment Action Research Teams



## There are up to 200 places for the region's schools to join Tier 2 of this exciting project for 2018-19

The aim of the project it that all schools across the region will be part of the project by 2019-20. It is implemented in 3 Tiers

Tier 1 2017-18	Shirley Clarke is currently working with 2 research teams that include 27 schools across the region on developing different aspects of formative assessment and pedagogy
Tier 2	The intention is that the 27 Tier 1 schools, in conjunction with the GwE, leads
2018-19	around 6-8 schools each in similar research
Tier 3	The rest of the schools in the region join, working in research teams of
2019-20	3-4 schools

It is anticipated that many successful networks will be established across the region that will continue to research, innovate and collaborate to develop good practice in the field of pedagogy in the future.

The schools selected for Tier 2 will work in action research teams of 6-8 throughout 2018-19 following the work of Shirley Clarke, one of the main international authorities on formative assessment. Her current work with the Tier 1 schools is exciting and progressive and is already having a positive impact on many levels.

This work naturally fits in with most school's SIP priorities and addresses much of the national and regional priorities for the future such as:

- Education in Wales: Our national Mission and preparations for Curriculum for Wales
- Schools in Wales as learning organisations the 7 key areas
- Using research to develop innovative and current pedagogical practice
- Further develop a climate of effective collaboration and self- improvement in schools
- The national professional standards for teachers and leaders
- National teachers' workload reduction agenda

Above all, it's an excellent opportunity for all the teachers of the region to develop and deepen their teaching skills and their understanding of the principles of excellent formative assessment and pedagogical practice. This in turn will develop our pupils to be the independent and confident learners they deserve to be.

#### Who can take part?

All schools from all sectors across the region are invited to apply.

If chosen, there will be **two teachers** from each school on the project. These two teachers will then attend all the training and review sessions and lead on developments back at school.

Small schools can consider applying jointly by releasing a teacher each from each school and collaborating.

#### What are the expectations from the school during the year?

- The **two teachers** who will be leading in the school to attend the above during 2018-19. Also experiment and develop very good teaching practice in their classes and disseminate good practice across the school.
- The **two teachers and their pupils** to complete questionnaires at each end of the year two for staff and one for pupils to measure the impact of the project
- The **head teacher** to support the project and allow the teachers to experiment in their classes. Also to promote the dissemination of good practice within the school

#### What are the further expectations from the school?

- The two teachers to share the impact of their work in showcase in the lead school.
- Be prepared to work, in conjunction with GwE, to lead 3-4 Tier 3 schools to conduct similar research and developments in 2019

#### Who will finance the collaboration?

**GwE** will pay the costs releasing the two teachers from each school for 4 days each and the costs of training and support from GwE and the lead schools.

**Schools** will be required to fund any further action they deem necessary in their schools e.g. Additional visits to lead schools, releasing teachers for research planning, collaboration, leading within the school.

#### How will GwE work with schools during the project?

Stella Gruffydd is the regional co-ordinator. The project also has 3 link Supporting Improvement Advisors - Catrin Roberts (Fflint and Wrecsam), Gwenno Jones (Gwynedd and Môn) and Paul Davies (Conwy and Dinbych). All schools' SIA will also support collaboration.

#### How will the project's effect be measured?

GwE is working with Bangor University to collect data and measure the impact of collaboration on the quality of teaching, and on pupils' experiences and development. This will mainly be by means of questionnaires and there will be some interviews in a few schools. The University will be responsible for collating and reporting on the data. We will also gather information through discussions and through short reports by schools on the impact of their research.
