benefits of learners, and the resources and sources of expertise required to support teachers and educational professionals as enquirers.

This interactive workshop will explore key themes from research findings and create a space for free and frank debate focused on the value of research to inform and support educative mentoring to develop pedagogical practice in Wales.

The event will help participants to critique the 'what works' agenda and think strategically about the implications of research findings for achieving principled change in practice within their own education contexts – as teacher education providers and as school practitioners. Research extracts, quotations, data samples and tables would be used as sources to provoke participant responses and debate the contribution of the material to designing professional learning that can lead to improved outcomes for learners. Through these activities, we will begin to address the conflicted understandings among stakeholders about 'research' and its potential to impact on teachers' practice for the
