Y prynhawn yma, cyhoeddodd y Gweinidog Addysg, Kirsty Williams, fanylion am y camau nesaf i ysgolion yng Nghymru, gan roi cyfle i “Ddod i’r Ysgol, Dal Ati i Ddysgu, Paratoi ar gyfer yr Haf a Mis Medi”.

Bydd y chwe Awdurdod Lleol a GwE yn gweithio mewn partneriaeth i barhau i'ch cefnogi wrth i chi weithio gyda chymunedau eich ysgol i gynllunio dull graddol sy'n gweddu i'ch ysgol chi. Hoffem eich sicrhau y byddwn yn parhau i fod mewn cysylltiad rheolaidd â chi i hysbysu, cefnogi a gwrandao wrth i chi barhau i baratoi ar gyfer y cam nesaf.

Fel rhan o'r datganiad a roddwyd heddiw, bydd Llywodraeth Cymru yn cyhoeddi canllawiau i gefnogi ysgolion yr wythnos nesaf, gan gynnwys gwybodaeth am reoli cyfleusterau a threfniadau ymarferol, yn cynnwys adeiladau, adnoddau, glanhau a thrafnidiaeth. Fodd bynnag, mae gwaith rhanbarthol ar ddatblygu fframwaith gefnogol wedi bod yn mynd rhagddo a byddwn yn rhannu hyn gyda chi yfory, dydd Iau 4 Mehefin. Bydd y cyntaf o'r rhain yn cynnwys:

- asesiad risg ac agweddau i'w hystyried yn eich lleoliadau eich hun fel cam cyntaf hanfodol yn y broses
- dogfennaeth i gefnogi lles cyffredinol i bawb
- enghreifftiau o ohebiaeth â rhieni a'r gymuned
- yr amserlen ar gyfer rhyddhau dogfennaeth bellach

Regional Education Update #3

Dear Headteachers,

This afternoon Education Minister, Kirsty Williams, published details of the next phase for schools in Wales, providing opportunities to “Check in, Catch Up, Prepare for summer and September”.

The 6 Local Authorities and GwE working in partnership will continue to support you as you work with your school community to plan a phased approach that is right for your school. Please feel reassured that we will continue to be in regular contact with you to inform, support and listen as you continue preparing for the next phase.

As part of today's statement, Welsh Government will publish guidance to support schools next week, including information on managing facilities and logistical arrangements, including buildings, resources, cleaning and transport. However, regional work on developing a supportive framework has been ongoing and we will share with you tomorrow, Thursday 4th June, the first of these which will include:

- *a risk assessment and aspects for your consideration within your own settings as a crucial first step in the process*
- *documentation to support universal wellbeing for all*
- *some examples of communication with parents and community*
- *release schedule of further documentation*
