TEACHER AS DESIGNER FOR INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGES IN WALES



Wales is undergoing a huge shift in its education system, with a new curriculum focused on the development of the individual and the quality of the learning journey (rather than content and coverage). Within its prescribed framework, Curriculum for Wales (CfW) allows each school to tailor their courses to their context and their vision. What was 'MFL' is now 'International Languages' and is part of the Languages, Literacy and Communication Area of Learning and Experience (AoLE). The vision is clear: the teacher's role is to ensure our students celebrate languages and their cultures. The Curriculum encourages multilingualism to thrive, and learners to develop a positive curiosity; the intent is to provide them with a firm foundation and lifelong interest in the languages of Wales and of the world.

At LanguageWorld (LW) 2022, Dr Jennifer Eddy had led a session outlining the creation of tasks which incorporate authentic texts with creative outcomes, support progression across levels and have intercultural competence in mind. These AATTs (Articulated Assessment Transfer Tasks) encourage pupils to think creatively and communicate with others, using language they own with immediacy.

Welsh delegates immediately realised that the process of AATT

creation is very flexible, aligns with the vision of CfW in many ways and can suit any school or curriculum priority.

The conversations after the session had far-reaching impact! As a consequence, at LW 2023, a group of North Wales teachers with Stephanie Ellis-Williams and Jennifer Eddy presented example materials they had created, students' work, and professional reflections.



CfW gives teachers the freedom to design the curriculum they have always wanted, and to provide purposeful, relevant experiences through effective pedagogical approaches. The main challenge for practitioners was to gain a deep understanding of the new curriculum framework and how its elements fit together to make effective and practical classroom practice within the Languages, Literacy and Communication AoLE.
