WE'RE KEEN TO HEAR FROM CLUSTERS AND/OR SCHOOLS INTERESTED IN PILOTING AN EVIDENCE-INFORMED PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR TEACHING LITERACY WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF YORK, BANGOR UNIVERSITY, AND GWE

The DEMSRI project is an extension of an earlier successful project, DEMSRI, which found 4-days of teacher CPD led to educationally significant gains of between 9 – 13% across classes in spelling and reading. In this project, we are seeking to support teachers in developing and implementing their evidence-based knowledge of teaching reading and spelling to children in Years 2 and 3. We wish to work with up to 40 schools between January and March 2025 to evaluate a three-day CPD course for classroom teachers. We are especially interested to hear from schools in a cluster that might be interested in working with us. More information on the DEMSRI project here.




